Addendum to the Water Quality Report:

The Selma Water Works & Sewer Board (SWWSB) incurred a lead and copper reporting violation during 2019. This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. Even though this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct this situation.

The ADEM Admin. Code r. 335-7-11-.17(1) states, "Water systems shall provide each customer with the results of any lead and copper monitoring conducted at the customer's tap. These results shall be provided to the customers within 30 days of receipt of the results by the water system." The violation was for failing to notify all of the customers and providing proof to ADEM within the 30 days following the January – June 2019 monitoring results.

We have since notified the customers and have submitted the required documentation to ADEM. We will continue to monitor for lead and copper on our assigned monitoring schedule, notify our customers within the required time, and submit the proper documentation and certification to ADEM by the deadline. Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
